

**CALL FOR ADMISSION TO THE FIRST YEAR
ACADEMIC YEAR 2025/2026**

RESERVED FOR ITALIAN, EUROPEAN AND NON-EUROPEAN CITIZENS REGULARLY RESIDENT IN ITALY

Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programme in Medicine and Surgery (LM-41)
Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programme in Medicine and Surgery - "MedTech" (LM-41)

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

This document is only the translation of the call for admission issued by the Rector's Decree on 30 October 2024, no. 656 for the Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programmes in Medicine and Surgery and Medicine and Surgery- "MedTech". The Italian version is the official document regulating this call. The document written in English has no legal value. In case of conflicting issues between the English and the Italian version, the Italian version prevails.

The admission to the I year of the **Single-Cycle Master's Degree Programmes in Medicine and Surgery and Medicine and Surgery- "MedTech"** – both courses entirely taught in English – consists a selection process based on a written test and the participation in the merit ranking. Candidates may use the unique or the best score obtained in the written tests held on 8th January 2024 and 29th February 2024 (under the provision of Rector's Decree no. 602/2023)¹ and/or in the following test sessions that will take place in Rome:

- **first test session: written test scheduled in Rome on the 9th January 2025.** The time and the location of the test, along with the list of admitted candidates and assigned sectors, will be published by 20th December 2024 on the University's website on <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>. Candidates may compete with the score obtained in the written test on 9th January 2025 for either one and the other course. Therefore, in order to compete for both Courses (the Single Cycle Master's Degree Programme in Medicine and Surgery and/or the Single Cycle Master's Degree Programme in Medicine and Surgery -"MedTech"), it is necessary to submit two separate online applications for the admission test, one for each degree course, according to the deadlines and modalities established by Article 5 of this call.
- **second test session: written test scheduled in Rome on the 20th February 2025.** The time and the location of the test, along with the list of admitted candidates and assigned sectors, will be published by 14th February 2025 on the University's website on <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>. Candidates may compete with the score obtained in the written test on 20th February 2025 for either one and the other course. Therefore, in order to compete for both Courses (the Single Cycle Master's Degree Programme in Medicine and Surgery and/or the Single Cycle Master's Degree Programme in Medicine and Surgery -"MedTech"), it is necessary to submit two separate online applications for the admission test, one for each degree course, according to the deadlines and modalities established by Article 5 of this call.

The merit ranking for the admission to the a.y. 2025/2026 will be drawn up on the basis of the best score – or the unique score in case of participation to only one test session – obtained by the candidate among all the tests taken.

For the a.y. 2025/2026, the first winning candidate in the merit ranking of the *Medicine and Surgery Course*, and the first winning candidate in the merit ranking of the *Medicine and Surgery- "MedTech" Course* (with a ISEE Diritto

allo Studio 2025 or 2024 certificate, not exceeding € 28.000 (twenty-eight thousand/00))², will be awarded with **1 (one) scholarship each**, covering the 100% of the University tuition fee for the legal duration of studies (6 years). The scholarships are financed by the University Campus Bio-Medico di Roma and are reserved to Italian citizens, citizens of the European Union and non-EU citizens with equivalent status. The Annex A to this call for admission states both the deadlines and modalities for acceptance and the requirements for maintaining the scholarship in the years following the first year of the course.

The registration for the tests enables the candidates to access: (i) a simulator online of the written admission test, tool for preparation and self-assessment, (ii) the results of the tests taken, also in comparison with the results obtained by other candidates in the same test in order to allow the evaluation of one's own positioning (iii) access to the test taken with the score obtained and the number of correct/not given/incorrect answers.

For all the procedures referred to in this call, the University reserves the right to change the deadlines due to *force majeure*. In the event of a postponement of the test, the University may extend and/or re-open the deadline for online registration for admission.

The University reserves its right to open new selective procedures if the ones referred to in this call resulted in any remaining places. In case of any remaining places, a public notice will be published on the University website <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>. The notice indicates the number of available places, test date(s) and its terms, conditions and modalities that will equal the ones stated in this call for admission, except for the submission of the language certification (see. Art. 3.3) that will happen immediately with the application submitting and for the enrolment that is established in a single phase following the merit ranking' publication, without the necessity to send the application for the inclusion in the ranking list.

It is the candidate's own responsibility to check all notices regarding the competition procedure published on the University's website at <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea> in the dedicated sections to admission to the Degree Programmes of interest.

2. AVAILABLE PLACES

For the academic year 2025/2026, the number of available places are as follows:

- **Master's Degree Programme in Medicine and Surgery, 72 places;**
- **Master's Degree Programme in Medicine and Surgery-"MedTech", 68 places.**

The number of available places may vary according to the Decree of the Italian Ministry of Universities and Research (Ministero dell'Università e della Ricerca, M.U.R), in compliance with Italian Law no. 264, August 2nd, 1999.

The Decree will be published on the website <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>.

In case of a reduction of the number of available places pursuant to the Decree of the Italian Ministry of Universities and Research, the candidates enrolled - on the basis of the merit ranking list - in the places no more available as a

result of the ministerial Decree, will forfeit of the enrolment and will compete for any available places in the modalities provided for eligible candidates.

3. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

3.1. CITIZENSHIP

The only candidates who can participate in the procedure are Italian and European citizens and NON - European citizens regularly resident in Italy (art. 39(5) of Legislative Decree no. 286/1998, as subsequently amended and supplemented).

Applicants who participate in this Call for Admission violating the citizenship requirements set forth in this article will be excluded from the procedure.

3.2. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION

Candidates can participate in the admission test for the a.y. 2025/2026 only if they meet the citizenship requirements set out in Article 3.1 and if they are **already graduated or will obtain in the school year 2024/2025 a valid qualification to access to University** in their country of origin, in accordance with the provisions published annually by the Ministry for Education, University and Research on the website www.studiare-in-italia.it/studentistranieri.

The only academic qualification is the one obtained after at least 12 years of schooling. Candidates who have obtained an educational qualification from a foreign school system are obliged to provide a Declaration of Value (*Dichiarazione di Valore*) issued by the Italian diplomatic representations or, alternatively, a certificate issued by the Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA).

In case the local school system only provides for 11 or 10 years of schooling, the academic qualification is only valid if integrated with one or two years of university (in this case the candidate must prove to have passed successfully all the exams required for the years attended). The Foundation Year course at University Campus Bio-Medico of Roma is also recognised, for this purpose, but only if the candidate has passed the relevant exams.

Candidates applying for this call violating the aforementioned requirements concerning their educational qualification and in accordance with current legislation forfeit from enrolment.

3.3. KNOWLEDGE OF THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE

Admission to the Master's Degree Programmes in Medicine and Surgery and Medicine and Surgery- "MedTech" **requires the knowledge of English, at least B2 level of CEFR attested by one of the language certifications exclusively listed in Annex B**, which is an integral part of this call for admission.

Under penalty of exclusion from the enrolment procedure:

- a) **candidates must attach one of the mandatory language certifications listed in Annex B** in the appropriate field of the online application platform **before paying the registration fee**. After payment, the application can no longer be modified;
- b) **candidates who have not attached one of the language certifications exclusively listed in Annex B** in the relevant field of the online application platform by the deadline set out in letter a), **can take the test but will be marked with an asterisk in the PROVISIONAL MERIT RANKING** referred to in article 7. Those candidates have to proceed as follows: winning or eligible candidates in the *provisional merit ranking* that have not already attached one of the language certification exclusively listed in Annex B in their application, **have to access again to the registration platform, from 18th April 2025 and no later than 19th**

June 2025, 1.00 p.m. (CEST) with their credentials, attaching their language certification;

- c) **candidates who participated to the admission tests** issued by the Rector's Decree on 5th October 2023, no. 602, as graduates or students attending the last high school year in 2023/2024, who kept the score obtained in the test to be included in the merit ranking for the a.y. 2025/2026, that did not present a language certification or presented one different from those exclusively listed in Annex B, will be marked with an asterisk in the PROVISIONAL MERIT RANKING referred to in article and will **have to access again to the registration platform, from 18th April 2025 and no later than 19th June 2025, 1.00 p.m. (CEST)** with their credentials, attaching their language certification.

Statements of equivalence will not be accepted even if they are issued by Certifiers listed in Appendix B, nor will certificates of attendance or participation of the test be accepted.

No later than 4th July 2025 the FINAL MERIT RANKING will be published, with the only names of those candidates who have produced an appropriate language certificate within the terms indicated above.

Furthermore, eligible candidates will be excluded to complete the enrolment process – PHASE II referred to in article 8, or being called by scrolling, if they did not upload or send correctly a language certification by the above-described deadlines and manners or they uploaded or send a language certification different from those exclusively listed in Annex B.

The registration fee for the admission procedure is not refundable for any reason and there will be no reimbursement of the tuition fee paid except in cases expressly provided for in this Call. Applicants are therefore invited to obtain on time a language certificate among those listed in Annex B. It is the candidate's own responsibility to verify that the provided certification is one of those exclusively listed in Annex B.

4. CANDIDATES WITH LEARNING DISABILITIES (SLD) AND OR DISABILITIES

Candidates with invalidity and disabilities, pursuant to Law 104/92, and candidates with learning disabilities, pursuant to Law no. 170/2010, who require special conditions or special aids for the examination, must explicitly insert their request in the online application. They have to attach the related certification proving the disability or SLD level, issued in the country of residence and accompanied by a sworn translation in Italian or English that specifies the essential elements regarding the aforementioned benefits in order to enable the University to prepare accordingly to guarantee an equal participation in the tests.

The University reserves the right to verify the candidate's certification and undertakes to inform the candidate, in due time for the test, of the aids granted. Only certifications produced in Italian or English will be considered.

4.1 CANDIDATES WITH INVALIDITY OR DISABILITIES

Candidates with invalidity or disabilities, pursuant to Law 104/92, who attached the related proving certification, stated in the art. 4 of the Call, will benefit from **additional time** for the written test, **not exceeding the 50%** of the regular time that is 1 hour and 50 minutes. Candidates can request additional aid by explicitly indicating it in the online application. The University may provide:

- An enlarged format of the written test (valid only for visual disabilities);
- A transcriber or a reading tutor (subjected to certification assessment).

4.2 CANDIDATES WITH LEARNING DISABILITIES

Candidates diagnosed with specific learning disabilities (D.S.A.), pursuant to Law no. 170/2010, who produced the related proving certification stated in the art. 4 of the Call, that must be no older than 3 years from the date of publication of this Notice and must clearly report the diagnostic summary and the relevant nosographic reference codes of the specific certified disorder, are entitled to **additional time, not exceeding the 50%** of the regular time that is 1 hour and 50 minutes. Candidates can request additional aid by explicitly indicating it in the online application. The University may provide:

- A not-scientific calculator (will be provided during the test, valid only for learning disabilities regarding the area of calculation or in response to a specific prescription in the diagnosis);
- A reading tutor (subjected to certification assessment);
- An enlarged format of the written test (subjected to certification assessment).

5. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

In order to participate to the admission test sessions of 9th January 2025 and 20th February 2025, the application must be submitted exclusively online by clicking on the appropriate button on the website <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea> in the mandatory following periods:

Registration for admission requires all the following actions **within the deadlines established in the table above:**

1. Registration on the online portal and creation of credentials (username and password)³;
2. Registration confirmation on the portal through the link that the candidate receives by email;
3. **Access to the portal with the candidate's credentials and filling in the application form;**
4. Online payment, by credit card, of the registration fee for the admission test.

The registration is considered completed only by following steps from point 1 to 4. Once all the mandatory fields of the registration form have been completed, the payment of the registration fee is automatically enabled.

The candidate receives an email containing the link to confirm the creation of the portal access credentials and then, if correctly filled in the application form and made the online payment, a further email confirming that the application has been submitted. The application is submitted only if received the confirmation of the online payment. At this point, the registration can no longer be modified.

An application that has not been submitted correctly is in any case considered incomplete and does not permit the participation in the competition. The registration fee for the test is not refundable under any circumstances.

Except for those who submit their application to both the two sessions by choosing the registration option with the reduced fee, each application is separated and independent of any other. Thus, in order to participate to the 2nd session of the admission test, each candidate has to complete another specific application and pay the fee again, although she/he already took the test in the 1st session.

It is the candidate's responsibility to check the correct insertion of the data requested by the online registration platform. The insertion of untruthful or incorrect data, or failure to enter them, will result in the exclusion from the procedure and from the final ranking or in the loss of the right to enrol or in the cancellation of the enrolment. The University Campus Bio-Medico of Rome reserves the right to carry out the necessary checks on the declarations made by the candidate.

The list of **candidates admitted to the written test** will be published on the University website at <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea> as follows:

- **by 20th December 2024 for the 1st session** (written test scheduled on 9th January 2025);
- **by 14th February 2025 for the 2nd session** (written test scheduled on 20th February 2025).

A simulator of the written admission test will be available on the registration platform. The candidates may use the simulator for practice purposes.

6. WRITTEN ADMISSION TEST

The written admission test (entirely in English) lasts **1 hour and 50 minutes** and consists of **80 multiple-choice questions as follows: Logic (50 questions), Biology (10 questions), Chemistry (10 questions), Mathematics and Physics (10 questions)**. The syllabuses for each discipline are contained in Annex C to this call for admission.

The test questions are extracted from an archive owned by the University Campus Bio-Medico of Rome, through a randomised procedure carried out by a qualified external actor in charge for this purpose. In consideration of the provisions of Article 1 letter b) of this call, different tests of equal difficulty will be prepared for each exam session, in accordance with the criteria for balancing the various question types.

By the end of the test (1 hour and 50 minutes) or in any case within a voluntary advanced delivery, each candidate must answer a further 6 reserve questions that will not count towards the test score unless an anomaly emerges in one or more questions. Only in this case, having ascertained the possible criticality, the Responsible for the proceeding, having obtained the opinion of the General Commission, may consider neutralising the question and replacing it with the reserve question of the same type in order to guarantee the objectivity of the assessments and equal treatment between candidates.

During the test, candidates are not allowed to use any electronic device, or any other types such as calculators, tablet, internet enabled devices, printed books, manuscripts or notes. Each candidate has the right to finish the test before the maximum time expires as well as to use all the minutes available.

The delivery of the test will not be allowed in the last 10 minutes of the scheduled time.

A candidate who wants to leave the venue must hand in the test and leave the location.

Points are assigned as follows:

1 point for each correct answer;

- 0,2 points for each incorrect answer;

0 points for each not given answer.

The highest achievable score in the written test is 80/80 points.

Only candidates with a total score that is equal or higher than 16/80 are considered eligible for the admission to the first year. Candidates who are not eligible (with a total score less than 16/80) will not be included in the ranking list.

7. ADMISSION TO THE MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMMES

7.1 APPLICATION FOR INCLUSION IN THE MERIT RANKING LIST

After participating in one or more written test sessions (9th January 2025 and/or 20th February 2025), eligible candidates with the requirements of Article 3 have to send their application for the inclusion in the merit ranking list for the a.y. 2025/2026 **exclusively from 5th March 2025 until no later than 12th March 2025, 1.00 pm CET by using the online registration platform.**

In order to correctly apply for the inclusion in the merit ranking list for the a.y. 2025/2026, the candidate has to complete within the above-stated deadline all the following mandatory steps⁴:

1. click on the appropriate button accessible at the following link:
<https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>;
2. access to the portal with the candidate's credentials created for the registration to the admission test session(s) (*in the event of loss, the candidate can retrieve the credentials by clicking on the appropriate button of the portal*);
3. declare to be in possession of all the requirements stated by the call for admission, Article 3;
4. check the score calculated by the system as the best one, in case in which the candidate has taken more than one written test;
5. check the single score calculated by the system, in case in which the candidate has taken only one written test;
6. click on the button "Presenta Istanza" ("Submit the application" in the English version of the online registration platform), in order submit the application for the inclusion in the merit ranking list.

In order to compete for the scholarship listed in Article 1 of this call, candidates have to upload in the appropriate section of the registration platform their ISEE Diritto allo Studio 2025 or 2024 certificate before submitting the application for inclusion in the merit ranking list.

The application for inclusion in the merit ranking list for the a.y. 2025/2026 is correctly submitted only after having completed all the steps from 1 to 6.

In any case, an application that has not been submitted is considered not completed and does not allow the candidate to participate in the admission process. The registration fee for the test is not refundable under any circumstances.

After submitting the application by clicking on the button "Presenta Istanza" ("Submit the application" in the English version of the online registration platform), the candidate receives an email that confirms that the application has been successfully submitted. Moreover, the platform indicates the application as "istanza trasmessa correttamente" ("Application submitted" in the English version of the online registration platform /submitted).

At this point, the application can no longer be modified.

It is the candidate's own responsibility to check the correct insertion of the data requested by the online registration platform. The insertion of untruthful or incorrect data, or failure to enter them, will result in exclusion from the procedure, the exclusion from the final ranking and in the loss of the right to enrol or in the cancellation of the enrolment. The University Campus Bio-Medico of Rome reserves the right to carry out the necessary checks on the declarations made by the candidate.

7.2 PROVISIONAL MERIT RANKING

After having submitted the applications for the inclusion in the merit ranking list under Article 7.1, the provisional merit rankings – one related to the Master's Degree Programme in Medicine and Surgery and one referred to the Master's Degree Programme Medicine and Surgery- "MedTech" – are published **within the 21st March 2025** by Rectoral Decree on the website at the link <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>.

The rankings are based on the best score (or on the single score, in case of participation in only one admission test session) achieved by each candidate, upon the application submitted by the candidate for inclusion in the merit ranking list. The placement of the candidates in the rankings is established on the basis of their scores for a

Programme and another application for inclusion in the merit ranking list of the Master's Degree in Medicine and Surgery-"Medtech" Programme.

maximum score of 80/80.

In the event of a tie in the test score, the candidate with the highest score achieved in the Logic questions prevails; in the event of a further tie, the candidate with the highest score in the Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics questions prevails. If the tie still persists, the candidate with the youngest age prevails.

The following candidates are considered *winners*:

- the first 72 candidates in the merit list for the Master's Degree Programme in Medicine and Surgery;
- the first 68 candidates in the merit list for the Master's Degree Programme in Surgery-"MedTech".

Candidates with a total score that is equal or higher than 16/80 are considered *eligible* for the admission to the first year. Candidates with a total score of less than 16/80 are considered *not eligible* for admission to the first year.

Each candidate can check their own position in the ranking list by means of the code assigned at the time of registration for the competition procedure from the online platform and referred to as "Unique ID".

8. ENROLMENT PROCEDURE

PHASE I

Following the publication of the *provisional merit ranking*, the **winning candidates** must proceed with the enrolment procedure – Phase I **from 24th March 2025 and no later than 4th April 2025, 1.00 p.m. (CEST)** performing the following actions published on the university website <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>:

- a) create the student's credentials on the University platform;
- b) with the student's credentials, login to the reserved area and pay of € 8.000,00 (eight thousand/00) equal to the amount of the first tuition fee^{5;6};
- c) send or hand-deliver the payment receipt of the instalment of the first tuition fee (letter b) to the Student Services Office by fax to (+39) 06.225411939 or by certified mail to segreteria.studenti@postasicura.unicampus.it.

The winning candidate who does not carry out all the operations referred to in the aforementioned points a), b) and c) no later than 4th April 2025, 1.00 p.m. (CEST), shall be automatically deemed withdrawn.

As from 11th April 2025, eligible candidates compete for any remaining places (not assigned to winning candidates by 4th April 2025) according to the merit ranking order.

Notice of remaining places is published on the University website <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>.

Notice of remaining places is normally published on Tuesdays and Fridays (except for Italian holidays). The notice

In the event of discrepancies between amounts or deadlines of the instalments reported in this call for admission and in the provisions of the Regulations for fees and contributions for the 2025/2026 a.y., published on the website <https://www.unicampus.it/ammissioni-corsi-di-laurea/tasse-e-contributi/>, the second one prevails.

Candidates included in the *final ranking* who have already completed the enrolment PHASE I, must proceed to enrolment PHASE II from 11th July 2025 and no later than 25th July 2025, 1.00 p.m. (CEST) following the "enrolment instructions" that will be published on the website <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>:

- d) access the student's reserved area on the University platform and payment of the regional tax for the Right to higher education, with the amount of € 140.00 (one hundred and forty/00)⁷; and the enrolment form;

 - the payment receipt of the regional tax for the Right to higher education;

The amount of the tuition fee referred to in article 8 can only be refunded to:

- candidates who do not obtain the High School Diploma valid for the admission in the a.y. 2025/2026;
- candidates, enrolled under conditions, who, as a result of the reduction in the number of places assigned annually by the Ministry for Education, University and Research, cease to be enrolled;
- candidates awarded with the scholarship financed by the Campus Bio-Medico University of Rome for the a.y. 2025/2026, assigned over the withdrawal of exempted candidates.

9. ADDITIONAL LEARNING OBLIGATIONS (OFA)

Admission test is based on the evaluation of the candidates fundamental competences needed for the successful attendance to the Degree Course.

Thus, before the classes start, all students who have completed their enrolment in accordance with the call for admission have to take a further test. This test aims at verifying any *Additional Educational Obligations (OFA)* in order to help the students in eventually filling the gaps in the core subjects of the first year.

Candidates who do not answer correctly to at least the 60% of the questions are admitted with OFAs for the subject they didn't pass the threshold.

In order to make up for the learning obligations (OFAs), the aforementioned candidates have to follow specific training courses. They will be informed at the beginning of the semester how to attend specific courses. In particular, OFAs must be completed before taking the relative exams foreseen in the study plan and in any case within the first year.

Alternatively, if the student passes the exams related to the OFAs, they may be considered as fulfilled.

SCHOLARSHIP ACCEPTANCE PROCEDURE

For admission to the academic year 2025/2026, the first winning candidate in the merit ranking for the Medicine and Surgery Course and the first winning candidate in the merit ranking for the Medicine and Surgery- “MedTech” Course – with the ISEE certification Diritto allo Studio 2025 or 2024 not exceeding € 28.000 (twenty-eight thousand/00) – will be awarded with **1 (one) scholarship each**. Each scholarship covers the 100% of the University tuition fee for the legal duration of the degree course (6 years). The scholarships are financed by the University Campus Bio-Medico di Roma and reserved to Italian citizens, citizens of the European Union and non-EU citizens with equivalent status.

For this purpose, before applying for the inclusion in the merit ranking list (by clicking on “Presenta/Submit button”) pursuant Article 7 of this call for admission, a copy of ISEE Diritto allo Studio 2025 or 2024 must be provided.

Scholarship beneficiaries, under penalty of forfeiture, must formally accept the scholarship within 26th March 2025, as specified in article 8 and note 4 of this call for admission.

SCHOLARSHIP RETENTION REQUIREMENTS

Students who have been awarded the scholarship referred to in point 1 of this Call for Admission may retain the benefit in the years following the first one within the legal duration of the course if, **by 31th October** of each year:

- a) they have acquired at least the same number of Academic Credits - ECTS (European Credit Transfer System - Credito Formativo Universitario - CFU) as shown in the tables hereunder:

- b) they have obtained a grade point average (GPA) in the exams relating to the total credits obtained at least equal to 27/30. The grade point average is rounded up to the next integer for decimal values of 5 or more.

In the event of forfeiture, revocation or withdrawal by students who have been awarded the scholarship, the remaining places will be allocated to those students who have obtained the highest number of ECTS with the highest average in the year preceding the year of allocation. This procedure, which may eventually be activated with a specific call for applications, is reserved for students enrolled at Campus Bio-Medico University of Rome in the academic year 2025/2026 who have an annual income (ISEE Diritto allo Studio) not exceeding € 28.000,00 (twenty-eight thousand/00).

The following candidates are not required to provide a language certification:

- a) candidates who have attended at least one year of high school **entirely taught in English** (having taken only certain subjects taught in English, even if for several consecutive school years, does not qualify for exemption);
- b) candidates who have taken the **BMAT test**.

Candidates referred to in letter (a) must provide, within the terms indicated above for the submission of language certification, a declaration of attendance issued by the High School with an explicit statement of the period of attendance and the language of teaching. For admission to the course a general knowledge in the fields of literature, history, philosophy, social and institutional studies is required, as well as the ability to analyse written texts, logical and mathematical reasoning skills.

Effects of electric currents (thermal, chemical, and magnetic).

Mathematics

Proportions and percentages. Powers with integer exponents, rational and their properties. Radicals and their properties. Logarithms (base 10 and base e) and their properties. Elements of combinatorics. Algebraic expressions, polynomials.

Major products, nth power of a binomial, factoring polynomials. Algebraic fractions. Algebraic equations and inequalities of the first and second grade. Systems of equations.

- Functions: fundamental notions about the functions and their graphical representations (domain, codomain, sign, maxima and minima, and monotonicity, etc.). Elementary functions: algebraic integer and fractional, exponential, logarithmic, trigonometric. Composite functions and inverse functions. Trigonometric equations and inequalities.
- Geometry: Polygons and their properties. Circumference and circle. Measurements of lengths, areas, and volumes. Isometries, similarities, and equivalences in the plan. Loci. Measure of angles in degrees and radians. Sine, cosine, tangent of an angle and their significant values. Trigonometric formulas. Solving triangles. Cartesian reference system in the plane. Distance between two points and the midpoint of a segment. Equation of the line. Terms of parallelism and perpendicularity.
