

PROCEDURE OF ADMISSION TO THE FIRST YEAR
Bachelor's Degree Course in Biomedical Engineering (L-8)
A.Y. 2026/2027

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

This document is only the translation of the procedure of admission issued by the Rector's Decree on 12th December 2025, no. 647 for the Bachelor's Degree Course in Biomedical Engineering. **The Italian version is the official document regulating this procedure. The document written in English has no legal value. In case of conflicting issues between the English and the Italian version, the Italian version prevails.**

For the admission to the I year of the Bachelor's Degree in Biomedical Engineering for the academic year 2026/2027 there are **60 places** available, **15** of them are reserved for foreign students living abroad. These places are allocated through the "Sessione Summer School" under RR.DD. April 16, 2025 n. 231 - until the number of available places is exhausted - in the order of submission of the application after verifying the candidate's requirements (without any test). Applications for admission may be submitted by candidates in the following calls and as specified below:

I CALL AND "PERCORSO DI ECCELLENZA" WITH SCHOLARSHIP

Within the first enrollment window, in accordance with the terms and procedures outlined in Annex A, up to three (3) candidates will be selected for admission to the "Percorso di eccellenza" of the Bachelor's Degree Programme in Biomedical Engineering. Selected candidates will be awarded a scholarship covering 50% of the university tuition fee for the entire three-year programme, subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility and continuation requirements specified in Annex A.

Within the second enrollment window, in accordance with the terms and procedures outlined in Annex A, one (1) candidate will be selected for admission to the Percorso di Eccellenza of the Bachelor's Degree Programme in Biomedical Engineering. The selected candidate will receive a scholarship covering 50% of the single university tuition fee for the entire three-year programme, subject to the eligibility and continuation requirements set out in Annex A. The number of available places in the Percorso di Eccellenza during the second enrollment window may be increased in the event that one or more scholarships are not awarded during the previous window.

The "Percorso di Eccellenza" aims to reward students according to merit criteria. Students admitted to the "Percorso di Eccellenza" will benefit from the support of a referent lecturer and will devote themselves to additional and complementary training activities. All training activities provided by the "Percorso di Eccellenza", which may also be carried out abroad through the Mobility Programme "Erasmus", requires a minimum annual commitment of the student of 4 CFUs in the 1st and 2nd year of the course, but does not give rise to the recognition of CFUs to obtain the University Degree issued by the University Campus Bio-Medico of Rome. Students will receive instead a certificate of completion of the "Percorso di Eccellenza", which will be recorded in the student's career in terms of extracurricular CFUs that will be included in the Diploma Supplement.

Selected students will benefit from:

- 50% exemption from the payment of the contribution fees for the three years;
- about 30-hours of English course to improve language skills (**provided on request**)
- activities organised in cooperation with other academic institutions or international organisations.

The selection and the maintaining of the benefits are subordinated to the verification of specific requirements set out in Annex A.

2. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

2.1. CITIZENSHIP

Only the following candidates may participate in the admission procedures that is set out in this procedure, on the basis of the entry requirements for each call referred to in Article 1.

- a) European citizens and NON - EU citizens regularly resident in Italy (art. 39(5) of Legislative Decree no. 286/1998, as subsequently amended and supplemented), who have obtained or will obtain in the academic year 2025/2026 the High School Diploma or another valid qualification obtained abroad to access to University (in accordance with the provisions published annually by the Ministry of Education, University and Research on the website www.studiare-in-italia.it/studenti stranieri).
- b) NON – EU citizens not resident in Italy who need a long-stay visa. Each candidate must submit the visa application in accordance with the provisions published annually by the Ministry of Universities and Research on the following website www.studiare-in-italia.it/studenti stranieri.

Please note that pre-enrolment at the university does not in any way guarantee an appointment at the diplomatic-consular offices for the submission of visa applications. It should also be noted that, as already stated in the ministerial circular entitled 'Procedure per l'ingresso, il soggiorno, l'immatricolazione degli studenti internazionali e il relativo riconoscimento dei titoli, per i corsi della formazione superiore in Italia valide per l'anno accademico 2025-2026' ('Procedures for the entry, stay, enrolment of international students and the related recognition of qualifications for higher education courses in Italy valid for the academic year 2025-2026') on page 7, the prior acceptance of a candidate by the university does not confer any right to obtain a visa, given that the issuance of study visas is the exclusive responsibility of the individual diplomatic-consular representations.

2.2. EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION

Candidates who meet the citizenship requirements set out in Article 2.1 above and who are graduating in the s.y. 2025/2026 or already graduated may take part in the admission procedures for the academic year 2026/2027. The only valid academic qualification is the one obtained after at least 12 years of schooling. Candidates who have obtained an academic qualification from a foreign school system are required to provide a Declaration of Value (*Dichiarazione di Valore*) issued by the Italian diplomatic representations or, alternatively, a certificate issued by the Information Centre on Academic Mobility and Equivalence (CIMEA).

In case the local school system only provides for 11 or 10 years of schooling, the academic qualification is only valid if integrated with one or two years of university (in this case the candidate must prove to have passed successfully all the exams required for the years attended).

2.3. LANGUAGE CERTIFICATION

Admission to the Bachelor's Degree Programme in Biomedical Engineering requires the knowledge of English, at least B2 level of CEFR attested by one of the language certifications listed in Annex B, which is part of this procedure.

Candidates, who are in possession of one of the language certifications listed in Annex B, must attach it in the appropriate field of the online application by the deadline for registration set out in the following

Article 4.

After the admission procedure, winning and eligible candidates who have not produced one of the language certificates exclusively indicated in Annex B in the online application, will appear in the merit ranking marked with an asterisk. Under penalty of forfeiture of enrolment, these candidates must deliver by hand or send the language certification exclusively indicated in Annex B to the Students Office (by PEC segreteria.studenti@postasicura.unicampus.it) by:

- No later than 24th July 2026 (for the I call and the possible II call);
- 5 (five) working days from the date of publication of the merit ranking (for the possibles III and IV calls).

Candidates who do not present the language certification or who present a different certification from those exclusively listed in Annex B, will be excluded from the enrolment procedure.

The registration fee for the admission procedure is not refundable for any reason and there will be no reimbursement of the tuition fee paid except in cases expressly provided for in this procedure. **Applicants are therefore invited to obtain a language certificate among those listed in Annex B on time. It is the candidate's own responsibility to verify that the provided certification is one of those listed in Annex B.**

It is the candidate's responsibility to check the correct insertion of the data requested by the Procedure, the online registration platform and/or during the enrolment process. The insertion of untruthful or incorrect data, or failure to enter them, will result in the exclusion from the procedure and in the loss of the right to enrol or in the cancellation of the enrolment. The University Campus Bio-Medico of Rome reserves the right to carry out the necessary checks on the declarations made by the candidates.

3. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

The application form must be submitted exclusively online by clicking on the appropriate button on the website <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea> from:

- from December 15th, 2026 to 1.00 p.m. CEST on February 26th, 2026, for the I call (with selection for the "Percorso di Eccellenza");
- from February 27th to 1.00 p.m. CEST on April 09th, 2026 for the II call (in case of remaining places);
- from April 10th to 1.00 p.m. CEST on July 09th, 2026 for the III call (in case of remaining places);
- from July 10th to 1.00 p.m. CEST on September 10th, 2026 for the IV call (in case of remaining places).

The II, III and IV calls are activated by public notice on the web page dedicated to admissions to the course, accessible from <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea> only in case of remaining places. In case of remaining places following the registration calls provided in this admission procedure, the University reserves the right to reopen the submission of online applications for registration to the Course by public notice made available on the web page dedicated to the Admissions and accessible from <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>. If applicable, In the case of active admission procedures during the lessons, the notice will also indicate how to register for the attendance.

Registration for admission requires performing all of the following actions from 1 to 7 by the aforementioned deadlines at the latest:

1. registration on the registration portal and creation of credentials (username and password)¹²;

¹ Only for candidates that have never registered into the registration platform.

² Candidates who already participated in the previous calls for admission, can recover their user and password only by clicking on "Forgot your credentials?" on the Login page. The administrative offices of the University are not responsible for resetting and recovering the candidates' credentials.

For technical issues regarding the online registration to the test, please contact the technical assistance by clicking on "Technical Support" on the online registration platform (button on the bottom of all the pages).

2. registration confirmation on the portal through the link that the candidate receives by email;
3. access to the portal with candidate's credentials and filling in the application form **by the deadlines of each call**;
4. download of the MAV form from your registration account;
5. online payment of the registration fee through the MAV form, **€ 50.00 (fifty/00) respecting the deadlines of each call**;
6. upload the payment receipt and the other documents required for application;
7. sending the application via the "PRESENTA/SUBMIT" button.

Registration is considered completed if the steps set out in points 1 to 7 are completed. The only payment of the registration fee or the only submission of the application does not constitute registration for the procedure.

An application that is not submitted (indicated by the online registration system as being in "draft" status), is in any case considered incomplete and does not allow the participation in the competition. The registration fee is not refundable under any circumstances.

The candidate receives an email with the link to confirm the created credentials to access the portal and an email confirmation of successful registration to the admission test, after clicking on the "PRESENTA/SUBMIT" button, containing the personal code "ID domanda". **The submitted application can no longer be modified.**

It is the candidate's responsibility to check the correct insertion of the data requested by the Procedure, the online registration platform and/or during the enrolment process. The insertion of untruthful or incorrect data, or failure to enter them, will result in the exclusion from the procedure and in the loss of the right to enroll or in the cancellation of the enrolment. The University Campus Bio-Medico of Rome reserves the right to carry out the necessary checks on the declarations made by the candidates.

4. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

At the end of each registration call, in the order of the time in which the applications were submitted, **the list of the candidates admitted to enrolment** is published on the web page dedicated to admission to the Course, accessible by <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/admissions-courses-degree>, **within 6 (six) working days** (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays in Italy) from the respective closing date for registration. Only for the I call, the candidates admitted to the oral interview referred to in Annex A of this Procedure will be marked with an asterisk.

Each candidate can check her/his own position in the ranking list by means of the code assigned at the time of registration for the competition procedure from the online platform and referred to as "ID domanda".

In the order of submission of the online application for the Bachelor's Degree (for this purpose, it is considered the date and time of transmission recorded automatically by the dedicated platform), applicants who meet the requirements set out in Article 2 shall be declared eligible for enrolment within the limit of the number of available places for each call.

Candidates who meet the requirements set out in Article 2, beyond the limit of available places for each call, shall be declared *eligible*. Upon completion of the enrolment of the admitted candidates, the eligible candidates are admitted to the enrolment for the coverage of any remaining places according to the order of submission of the online application for admission.

The eligible candidates are informed of the allocation of any remaining places by public notice on the web page of the Admission Procedure accessible from <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-courses> and have the possibility to enrol within the same time limits and in the same way as those referred to in Articles 5 and 6 below.

At each stage of the procedure, it is the sole responsibility of the candidate to check all notices published by the University on the web page dedicated to admission to the course, accessible from <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>.

5. ENROLMENT TO I AND II CALL

PHASE I

At the outcome of the admission procedure, the **winning candidates** of the I call and the possible II call, must proceed with the enrolment procedure – **Phase I**:

- **within 5 (five) working days from the publication of the list of the candidates admitted to enrolment** (for the I and II calls);
- **only for the candidates admitted to the oral interview for the access the “Percorso di Eccellenza” set out in Annex A³, within 5 (five) working days from the publication of the result of the oral interview.**

by carrying out the following actions and following the “registration instructions” that will be published by the enrolment opening on the website <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>:

- a) creation the student’s credentials on the University platform;
- b) login to the reserved area and payment of € 2.500,00 (two thousand and fifty/00)⁴, equal to the amount of the first instalment of the tuition fee,
- c) sending to the Student Services Office the receipt of payment of the first instalment (letter b).

Winning candidates who do not carry out all the beforementioned actions from the letter a), b), and c) within time shall be automatically considered withdrawn.

I CALL AND “PERCORSO DI ECCELLENZA” WITH SCHOLARSHIP

Candidates admitted to the **oral interview** for the purpose of awarding the benefits of the **Percorso di Eccellenza**, as referred to in **Article 1** and **Annex A** of these Admission Procedures, shall complete **Phase I enrollment** within the deadlines and according to the procedures indicated above, in the same manner as all other applicants. The **four (4) scholarship winners** must formally accept the scholarship within **two (2) working days** from the date of publication of the **Percorso di Eccellenza merit ranking** referred to in Annex A, by sending a certified email (PEC) confirming acceptance of the scholarship to the following certified email address: segreteria.studenti@postasicura.unicampus.it. Candidates selected for the **Percorso di Eccellenza**, and therefore awarded the corresponding scholarship, shall complete **Phase I enrollment** within the deadlines and according to the procedures indicated above. The scholarship provides a **50% exemption from the payment of the university tuition fee**, applied through an adjustment of the second and/or third installment.

Scholarship winners who fail to formally accept the benefit within the deadlines and according to the procedures outlined above shall **forfeit the scholarship**; however, they may still complete enrollment within the deadlines and according to the procedures set out in **Articles 5.1 and 5.2**.

At the outcome of the enrolment procedure, **eligible candidates will compete for any remaining places** following the merit ranking order.

Notice of remaining places is normally published on Tuesdays and Fridays (except for Italian holidays). The notice indicates the positions in the merit ranking that are allowed to enroll and the date from which the candidates have to communicate the acceptance of the offered place.

Eligible candidates are allowed to enrol following the steps established by the above-mentioned points a), b) and c), from the 12.00 pm CEST of the date indicated in the public notice and within no later than the 12.00 p.m. CEST of the working day after the notice has been published. The eligible candidate who does not complete all the required steps established by points a), b) and c) within the aforementioned deadline is automatically deemed withdrawn.

It is the candidate own responsibility to check in due time the communications published by University on the website.

With reference to the enrolling procedure, University fees are non-refundable under any circumstances.

PHASE II

Candidates who have completed enrolment - PHASE I by the deadlines and according to the procedures set out above (including candidates benefiting from scholarships linked to the Percorso di Eccellenza as set in art. 1 and Annex A), proceed to enrolment - PHASE II **from 10th July 2026 and not later than 24th July 2026 following the “enrolment instructions” that will be published on the following website <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>:**

- d) access the student’s reserved area on the University platform and payment of the regional tax for the Right to higher education, with the amount of € 140.00 (one hundred and forty/00)⁵; and the enrolment form;
- e) send or deliver to Student Services Office by certified mail to segreteria.studenti@postasicura.unicampus.it **no later than 24th July 2026 the following documents:**
 - the payment receipt of the regional tax for the Right to higher education;
 - the enrolment form duly completed signed in all its parts and affixed with a €16.00 (sixteen/00) revenue stamp;
 - a self-declaration of achievement of the Diploma of Higher Secondary Education with indication of the grade, year and Institute that issued it, with a declaration of value in case of foreign educational qualifications. In case of foreign qualifications, this declaration must be accompanied by a declaration of value issued by the Italian diplomatic representation or a certificate of comparability issued by the Italian ENIC-NARIC center (CIMEA);
 - the withdrawal from studies or no impediment to transfer in case of previous enrolment in another University.

Enrolment is considered conditional until the submission of the documentation referred to in the points d) and e), following the “enrolment instructions” that will be published on the following website <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>:

In the absence of such documentation, after 24th July 2026, these candidates will be deemed withdrawn from enrolment.

Referring to all stages of the procedure, the amount of the tuition fee referred to in article 6 can only be refunded to candidates who do not obtain the High School Diploma in the school year 2025/2026.

6. ENROLMENT PROCEDURE III AND IV CALLS

Winning candidates of the III call must proceed to enrolment **not later than 5 (five) working days after the publication of the merit ranking** (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Italian public holidays). **To enrol correctly, each candidate has to follow the “enrolment instructions” that will be published on the following website <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>:**

- a) create the student’s credentials on the University platform;
- b) with the student’s credentials, login to the reserved area and pay of € 2.640,00 (two thousand six hundred and forty/00)⁶ equal to the amount of the first tuition including the tax for the Right to higher education;
- c) send or deliver to Student Services Office by certified mail to segreteria.studenti@postasicura.unicampus.it **no later than 5 working days after the publication of the merit ranking** (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Italian public holidays).
 - the payment receipt of the regional tax for the Right to higher education;
 - the enrolment form duly completed signed in all its parts and affixed with a €16.00 (sixteen/00) revenue stamp;

- a self-declaration of achievement of the Diploma of Higher Secondary Education with indication of the grade, year and Institute that issued it, with a declaration of value in case of foreign educational qualifications. In case of foreign qualifications, this declaration must be accompanied by a declaration of value issued by the Italian diplomatic representation or a certificate of comparability issued by the Italian ENIC-NARIC center (CIMEA);
- the withdrawal from studies or no impediment to transfer in case of enrolment at another University

The winning candidate who does not carry out all the operations referred to in the aforementioned points (a), (b) and (c), no later than 5 working days after the publication of the merit ranking (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Italian public holidays), shall be automatically deemed withdrawn.

Eligible candidates compete for any remaining places (not allocated to winning candidates) in order of the merit ranking.

Notice of remaining places is normally published on Tuesdays and Fridays (except for Italian holidays). The notice indicates the positions in the merit ranking that are allowed to enroll and the date from which the candidates have to communicate the acceptance of the offered place.

Eligible candidates are allowed to enrol following the steps established by the above-mentioned points a), b) and c), from the 12.00 pm CEST of the date indicated in the public notice and within no later than the 12.00 pm CEST of the working day after the notice has been published. The eligible candidate who does not complete all the required steps established by points a), b) and c) within the aforementioned deadline is automatically deemed withdrawn.

It is the candidate own responsibility to check in due time the communications published by University on the website.

With reference to the whole enrolment procedure referred to in this Article 7, no reimbursement of the tuition fee paid shall be made.

7. ADDITIONAL EDUCATIONAL OBLIGATIONS (OFA)

At the beginning of the teaching semester, all students who have completed their **enrolment** in accordance with the procedure have to take a further test. This test aims at verifying any *Additional Educational Obligations (OFA)* in order to help the students in eventually filling the gaps in the core subjects of the first year.

SELECTION OF STUDENTS FROM THE “PERCORSO DI ECCELLENZA”

Applicants seeking admission to the **Bachelor’s Degree Programme in Biomedical Engineering** within the **first and second enrollment windows** may apply to participate in the selection procedure for admission of **four (4) candidates** to the so-called **Percorso di Eccellenza in Biomedical Engineering**, by explicitly indicating their interest in the appropriate section of the online application platform. Specifically, the selection provides for the admission of **up to three (3) candidates** within the **first enrollment window** and **one (1) candidate** within the **second enrollment window**. The number of candidates eligible for admission to the Percorso di Eccellenza within the second window may be increased if one or more benefits are not awarded during the previous window.

Participation in the selection procedure referred to in this Annex is open to applicants who meet the following requirements:

- a) a **grade point average of at least 7/10** in the **third-to-last year** of upper secondary school;
- b) a **grade point average of at least 7/10** in the **second-to-last year** of upper secondary school;
- c) **two (2) letters of reference**.

The selection procedure takes place on the same day and includes:

1. a **written test in English** (morning session). *Please note:* if a candidate also applies for the Percorso di Eccellenza within the Bachelor’s Degree Programme in **Industrial Engineering**, the written test will be **single, conducted in English, and valid for admission to the Percorso di Eccellenza of both degree programmes;*
2. for candidates who successfully pass the written test only, an **oral interview in English** (afternoon session on the same day as the written test). In the case of participation in the Percorso di Eccellenza selection for both Biomedical Engineering and Industrial Engineering, the oral interview will likewise be **single, conducted in English, and valid for both degree programmes**.

Please note: participation in this selection procedure does **not** concern admission to the degree programme, which is granted in order of application submission following verification of the candidate’s entry qualifications and without any entrance examination. The selection procedure is solely aimed at identifying those candidates—already admitted to the degree programme—who may access the Percorso di Eccellenza.

The **Percorso di Eccellenza** is designed to promote and enhance student achievement based on merit. Students admitted to the Percorso di Eccellenza will benefit from the guidance of a dedicated faculty mentor and will engage in **additional and complementary educational activities** alongside the standard curriculum. The overall set of activities envisaged under the Percorso di Eccellenza —some of which may also be carried out abroad through the **Erasmus Programme**—requires a **minimum annual commitment of 4 ECTS credits** during the first and second academic years. These activities do **not** lead to the recognition of curricular ECTS credits for the purposes of obtaining the academic degree awarded by Università Campus Bio-Medico di Roma; instead, students will receive a **certificate of completion** of the Percorso di Eccellenza, which will be recorded in their academic career as **extracurricular ECTS credits** and included in the **Diploma Supplement**.

Admission to the **Percorso di Eccellenza in Biomedical Engineering** includes the following benefits:

- a **50% reduction of the single university tuition fee** for the entire three-year programme;
- upon request, a **30-hour advanced English language course**;
- participation in activities organized also in collaboration with **international academic institutions or other organizations**.

Should no candidates be deemed eligible for admission to the Percorso di Eccellenza of the Bachelor’s Degree Programme in Biomedical Engineering during the dedicated selection sessions, in accordance with

the terms and procedures outlined below, the related benefits shall not be claimable by the candidates who participated in the procedure.

The list of candidates admitted to the **written test** will be published on the admissions webpage, accessible at <https://www.unicampus.it/it/info/ammissioni-corsi-laurea>, by:

- **6 March 2026**, for the first enrollment window;
- **17 April 2026**, for the second enrollment window.

The written test for admission to the Percorso di Eccellenza will be held **in person** at the University campus on the following dates:

- **12 March 2026, 8:30 a.m.**, for candidates applying within the first enrollment window;
- **23 April 2026, 8:30 a.m.**, for candidates applying within the second enrollment window.

The test, lasting **120 minutes**, consists of **15 multiple-choice questions in English**, including:

- **5 mathematics questions;**
- **5 physics questions;**
- **5 logical–scientific reasoning questions.**

Scoring is as follows:

- **+1 point** for each correct answer;
- **–0.2 points** for each incorrect answer;
- **0 points** for unanswered questions.

Candidates achieving a total score of **at least 9/15** in the written test are eligible to proceed to the subsequent oral interview. In the event of a tie, priority is given to the candidate with the higher score in mathematics questions, followed by physics, and then logical–scientific reasoning. Should the tie persist, priority is given to the **younger candidate**.

The alphabetical list of candidates admitted to the oral interview (to be held on the **afternoon of the same day as the written test**) will be published on the admissions webpage within **two hours** of the conclusion of the written test.

The oral interview will take place **in person** at Università Campus Bio-Medico di Roma and will be conducted in **English**, covering topics in mathematics, physics, and logical–scientific reasoning, with the aim of also assessing **analytical, argumentative, and motivational skills**. The oral interview is graded on a **30-point scale (N/30)**. The minimum score required for admission to the Percorso di Eccellenza is **27/30**.

The **successful candidates** for the Percorso di Eccellenza of the Bachelor's Degree Programme in Biomedical Engineering are the **top four (4) candidates** ranked according to the score obtained in the oral interview. In the event of a tie, priority is given to the candidate with the higher written test score. Should a further tie occur, priority is given to the candidate with the higher average grade between the third-to-last and second-to-last years of upper secondary school, and ultimately to the younger candidate. Candidates ranked below the winners who obtain a score of **at least 18/30** are declared **eligible** and may be considered for reassignment of the benefit, in ranking order, in the event of non-acceptance or withdrawal by successful candidates.

Following completion of the oral interviews, and no later than **20 March 2026** for candidates in the first enrollment window, or **30 April 2026** for candidates in the second enrollment window, the **merit ranking list**, valid exclusively for the purpose of awarding scholarships, will be published on the admissions webpage.

Successful candidates admitted to the Percorso di Eccellenza, and therefore awarded the relevant **scholarships**, must formally accept the benefit by:

- **24 March 2026**, for candidates in the first enrollment window;
- **4 May 2026**, for candidates in the second enrollment window, by sending a certified email (PEC) confirming acceptance of the scholarship to: *segreteria.studenti@postasicura.unicampus.it*.

Scholarship winners who accept the benefit within the prescribed deadlines and according to the procedures outlined above must complete **Phase I enrollment**:

- from **23 March 2026** and no later than **1:00 p.m. (CEST) on 27 March 2026**, for candidates in the first enrollment window;
- from **4 May 2026** and no later than **1:00 p.m. (CEST) on 8 May 2026**, for candidates in the second enrollment window, in accordance with the procedures set out in **Article 5.1**.

The scholarship provides a **50% exemption from the payment of the single university tuition fee**, applied through an adjustment of the second and/or third installment. Scholarship winners who have completed Phase I enrollment pursuant to Article 5.1 but fail to formally accept the benefit within the deadlines and according to the procedures described above shall **forfeit the scholarship**, while retaining the possibility to enroll under the terms and procedures set out in **Articles 5.1 and 5.2**.

If one or more successful candidates withdraw from the benefit by **26 September 2026**, candidates declared eligible for the Percorso di Eccellenza following the oral interview may be considered for assignment of the remaining scholarships, in merit ranking order, with **reimbursement of the university tuition fee already paid**.

SCHOLARSHIP RETENTION REQUIREMENTS

Beneficiary students will be able to retain the benefit of the scholarship and other benefits during the three-year period if they meet all the requirements set out in (a), (b) and (c) below **by 30th October** each year:

- a) they have acquired at least the same number of Academic Credits - ECTS (European Credit Transfer System - Credito Formativo Universitario - CFU) as shown in the tables hereunder:

- b) they have obtained a grade point average (GPA) in the exams relating to the total credits obtained at least equal to 28/30;
- c) have carried out the additional training activities where foreseen (“Percorso di Eccellenza”).

In the event of forfeiture, revocation or renunciation by students awarded with the scholarships linked to the “Percorso di Eccellenza”, exclusively for the 2nd year of the course, the scholarships shall be reallocated - within the limit of the residual amounts - to students enrolled in the 1st year of the Bachelor’s Degree Course in Biomedical Engineering in the academic year 2025/2026. The scholarships are reallocated only to those students who have met the requirements described above and in order of weighted average on 30th October 2026. Candidates taking over the 2nd year of the “Percorso di Eccellenza”, within the terms and according to the procedures described above, have to agree with the Departmental Faculty Bodies on the recovery of the extra-curricular training activities foreseen for the 1st year of the “Percorso di Eccellenza”. In particular, the activities planned for the 2nd year must be carried out within the deadlines set out in the present procedure to confirm the benefits in the 3rd year. The activities foreseen for the 1st year must be completed by the date of graduation.

Candidates who have attended a secondary school/university entirely taught in English for at least one academic year are exempt from submitting a language certification. These candidates must submit, within the deadlines and according to the procedures for submitting language certification, a certificate of attendance issued by the secondary school/university, explicitly stating the period of attendance and the language in which the courses were taught.
