DECLARATION OF COMMITMENT TO CONFIDENTIALITY AND COMPLIANCE WITH INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RULES

(hereinafter referred to as the “Purpose”);

- during this period, the undersigned may become aware, including accidentally and unintentionally, of “Confidential Information” belonging to UCBM or to third parties having relations with UCBM;
- “Confidential Information” means, without limitation, all documents, drawings, projects, prototypes, printed materials, data, materials, information, knowledge, inventions, experience and other materials contained in documents or on any other medium, as well as software, source code, algorithms, databases, any samples, know-how, information of an organisational or commercial nature, access credentials and any other information, including information disclosed orally, which comes to the undersigned’s knowledge in the course of the activities carried out at UCBM, as well as all data contained in patent applications owned by UCBM or available for its use, irrespective of whether direct legal protection may be obtained, including, by way of example, protection afforded by industrial property rights or copyright;
- the “Confidential Information” will be deliberately disclosed to the undersigned for the sole purpose of enabling him/her to carry out the activities relating to the Purpose;
- this undertaking also covers any further “Confidential Information” that may become known as a result of and/or in connection with the aforementioned activity and, more generally, during the period spent at UCBM;
- “personal data” means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (“data subject”); an identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to his/her physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity;
- “processing” means any operation or set of operations performed on personal data or on sets of personal data, whether or not by automated means, such as collection, recording, organisation, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction.

The above premises form an integral and substantive part of this declaration. The undersigned, under his/her own personal responsibility,

hereby undertakes to:

1. not use or communicate the “Confidential Information” to any third party, company or entity, nor disclose or disseminate it in any manner or by any means, including by reproduction, photography, copying, scanning, etc., without the express/explicit consent of UCBM, except for the Purpose referred to in the premises;
2. adopt all necessary measures to ensure that those who, by reason of the Purpose, necessarily require access, in whole or in part, to such “Confidential Information” maintain the strictest confidentiality in relation thereto;
3. return to UCBM, at the end of the period spent at UCBM, any and all documents or other media containing “Confidential Information” provided by UCBM in connection with such period;
4. acknowledge that UCBM makes no representation, warranty or assurance as to the adequacy or completeness of the Confidential Information disclosed;
5. comply with the obligations undertaken for a further period of 5 (five) years following the termination of the relationship with UCBM and/or the end of the period spent at UCBM, or for a longer period where expressly required in relation to specific Confidential Information;
6. keep UCBM regularly and promptly informed of all results relating to activities, tests, calculations, experiments or checks carried out, as well as of any technical and specialist assessments performed for the Purpose, and disclose any invention or solution that may be patentable or eligible for any other form of protection;
7. comply with the provisions of UCBM’s **“Regulation on Intellectual and Industrial Property”**, which the undersigned expressly declares to have read on the University’s institutional website, and to accept its contents in full. The PhD student also acknowledges that the Regulation governs the ownership of rights in favour of UCBM, without prejudice to the payment to the inventor of a share of the proceeds in accordance with the procedures set out therein;
8. accept the provisions concerning the management and protection of intellectual property contained in any specific agreements relating to the Purpose referred to in the premises;
9. acknowledge that UCBM remains the exclusive owner of any right, title and interest relating to the Confidential Information, as well as of any industrial and/or intellectual property rights held by UCBM, and that the disclosure of the Confidential Information shall not result in the granting of any licence or in the recognition or transfer of any right;
