

**ANNOUNCEMENT OF COMPETITION FOR THE ALLOCATION OF N. 5 GRANTS FOR PART-TIME COLLABORATIONS AT THE ORIENTATION OFFICE FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS AT CAMPUS BIO-MEDICO UNIVERSITY OF ROME FOR THE A.Y. 2020/2021**

This document is the English translation of the competition call issued by the Rector's Decree on 7th April 2021, no. 125 for the allocation of n. 5 grants for part-time collaborations. The Italian version is the official document regulating this call. The document written in English has no legal value. In case of conflicting issues between the English and the Italian version, the Italian version succeeds.

**1. Competition grants**

For the academic year 2020/2021, pursuant to art. 11 of Legislative Decree no. 68 of March 29, 2012, a competition is announced for the assignment of 5 part-time collaborations to non-EU students residing abroad enrolled at Campus Bio-Medico University of Rome, carrying out activities that support the Orientation Office. In particular, these students will be asked to collaborate in Open Days, orientation fairs, and present UCBM educational offer at schools.

The collaboration involves several activities of a maximum of 200 hours to be divided according to the needs of the Office.

**2. Compensation**

The remuneration for this collaboration, equal to € 8.00 per hour of activity, is tax-exempt; the collaboration does not constitute in any way a relationship of employment and does not give rise to any evaluation for public competitions (see Legislative Decree 68/2012, art.11, paragraph 3). The remuneration is paid to the scholarship holder in 2 installments: the first in July 2021, the second withing the following month when the activities are no longer needed, based on the report of the activities carried out.

**3. Participation Requirements**

Non-EU students residing abroad who are regularly enrolled, in the academic year 2020/2021, in a degree/master's degree program at Campus Bio-Medico University of Rome may participate in this contest.

**4. Submission of applications**

The application submission must be submitted exclusively online by May 3rd, 2021, by accessing the University e-learning page accessible at the following address <https://elearning.unicampus.it> with personal credentials. After logging in, access the Dashboard section at the top left and then Financial Aid (Diritto allo Studio), available among the University services (the first time you log in you will be asked to register without a password). On that page, it is possible to access the form "Part-time collaboration grants for foreign students - Orientation Office UCBM - a.y. 2020/2021", for the submission of the application form with the instructions for its completion.

The candidate must indicate in the application the academic career and income situation of the family of origin.

**5. Ranking**

The allocation of scholarships is based on the ranking drawn up by a special Commission defined through the joint score, which is equal to the sum of the following scores

1. Up to 30 points for grade point average (GPA)

2. Up to 6 points for the seniority of enrollment, as per the following table:

Year of Study	Points

IV	4
V	5
VI	6

3. Up to 30 points obtained through the oral test, which consists of an interview to be held from May 10th, 2021 with a specially appointed committee, aimed at ascertaining knowledge of English, relational aptitude, and motivation.

In the event of a tie, the student with the lowest value of the income indicator declared at the time of application takes precedence.

**6. Revocation**

The assignment of the collaboration is revoked in case of

- a) renunciation of the continuation of studies or transfer to another university location;
- b) completion of the degree course to which the student belongs;
- c) for causes that make the student unsuitable for the continuation of the collaboration (for example, certified and repeated lack of availability to the requests of the coordinator; declaration of the coordinator regarding unsuitable behavior for the service rendered).

In these cases, the compensation will be paid according to the duration of the collaboration, as indicated in art. 2, and the allocation of the remaining hours will go to the first eligible student.
